The clerk reported that a letter and monthly reported dated 31/5/11 has been received by email late today; this reported progress to date and explained the delay in the Metalock work being undertaken by 1 contractor, not 2. The letter also raised the issue of additional costs estimated at £1500 in respect of a compressor hire and fuel that had not been included in original price. The Chair, clerk and members were very shocked at this unexpected cost for which there is no budget provision as contingency has already been used for essential works. It was resolved for Clerk to respond and ask for full breakdown of costs, dates of hire and DJC dates Metalock in attendance and request where savings can be made on remaining project works. LVPF UPDATE/ Recreation Ground redevelopment project - 100 Club winner April 2011 - Dawn Wells, May 2011 - Mrs Tilly Van-Rees Cllr Marsden reported that equipment has been ordered from Playdale Playgrounds Ltd with delivery dates of either w/c 27/6/11 or 4/7/11. Mats have been ordered from Peter Clarke to cover scramble net area, it is planned to reuse the swing area mats. Cllr Marsden is liaising with Peter Clarke to sign-off the installation as soon as possible to it can come into use.
