The clerk reported that the Sports Club have decided that they are unable to continue with running toilets and undertake terms of new lease required by SLDC. Members of the Parish Council fully understand their reasons for the decision and are very grateful to them for all their hard work in recent years with regards to the toilets. Members agreed to meet as a sub-committee to consider the options now facing the Parish Council to retain the facility and establish the way forward. 1534 **FINANCE REPORT** A) CONSIDER THE FINANCE REPORT AS AT 19TH NOVEMBER 2010. Resolution to approve payment of accounts as listed on the attached schedule. Proposed Cllr Mrs McClure, Seconded Cllr Bond, all in favour. Proposed Cllr Mrs McClure, Seconded Cllr Bond, all in favour. 1535 PROPOSED DOG CONTROL ORDER IN RESPECT OF LINDALE RECREATION GROUND DC/JH/PB I) MEMBERS TO CONSIDER REPRESENTATIONS AND DRAFT LETTERS OF RESPONSE /RA/MS FOLLOWING PUBLIC CONSULTATION REGARDING PROPOSED DOG CONTROL ORDER. II) MEMBERS TO AGREE IF TO PROCEED WITH DCO UNDER THE OF CLEAN **NEIGHBOURHOOD AND ENVIRONMENT ACT 2006** Members considered the letters of support for proposed DCO and letters of representation. Following in-depth discussion members felt that there was a such a high level of objections to the section regarding "the exclusion of dogs" from the recreation DC ground. Members felt to proceed with the proposed terms of the DCO would cause a severe rift in the village and that to remove that section and proceed on basis of "Failing to clean up dog fouling and keeping Dogs on leads" would address the issues of fouling and dogs running around the recreation ground out of control. Concerns were also raised about the enforcement of the exclusion zone with regard to access over the footpath only. 5 Members voted for undertaking a 2nd consultation for a revised proposed order removing the exclusion zone section. 1 member voted not to proceed at all. It was therefore resolved to proceed with a 2nd Consultation period in respect of revised proposed DCO and new Public Notice in Westmorland Gazette. Clerk will also write to everyone who made representation advising them of the decision made. 1536 **ENVIRONMENT:-HIGHWAYS ISSUES** The clerk forwarded details of new and outstanding Highways Issues to County Councillor Wearing who investigated and responded – updates reported in meeting notes and items to be monitored and reviewed each month. LINDALE: i) Report regarding parish areas by member completing weekly inspections and SLDC monthly playground inspection report and update of action regarding grid in recreation

Clerk reported no issues regarding SLDC play area inspection.

Members noted it is becoming slippery again on access path from skateboard park to recreation ground over bridge – monitor on weekly inspections.

It was reported some seats are deteriorating rapidly, in particular Skinner Hill seat and by recreation ground toilets. Cllrs Hall and Armstrong to carry out full survey on all seats with view to removing as appropriate.

Noted bus shelter windows need staining- to be completed when weather improves in Spring 2011.

ii) Update on requests for relocation of litter bins – still outstanding clerk to follow up.

iii) Review rota for parish inspections.

October –Cllr Bond, November – Cllr Armstrong, December – Cllr Ms Hall, January – Cllr Mrs Tattersall, February – Cllr Bond, March – Cllr Armstrong. April – Cllr Squire (he will accompany members prior to this to establish routine) It was noted that some inspection were difficult to carry out during December due to snow and ice.

Cllr Armstrong agreed to remove wreaths from war memorial.

v) Highways Steward report.

The clerk ask Cllr Wearing if the new scheme was now operating as we have not been given any contact details of the stewards covering the parish. Cllr Wearing to investigate. **NEWTON-**

i) Report regarding parish areas by member completing weekly inspections No report available. Clerk to email copy of weekly inspection sheet to Cllr Marsden and details of CCC Hotline in order to report any highways issues identified.

ii) Update on action taken and work completed by Probation Service and agree budget/funding allocation.

All cutback work has now been completed, work still outstanding for:- Well area to be cleaned and gate repainted, path edges to be replaced and refurbishment of benches.

PARISH PROJECTS:

a) Wilkinson Monument: Update on progress

Still awaiting details of tenders from Robert Burgess, all forms in respect of English heritage grant returned to meet deadline of 6/1/11.

b) Windermere Road:

Lease now received from CCC. Application submitted to CWMET to meet deadline of 12/11/10 for cost of groundwork to clear, level and grass the land, application to be made to Taylor Newton and Hibbert Charity or other funder for balance of project when outcome of CWMET is known.

c) Recreation Ground upgrade project.

It was reported that there was a poor response to 100 Club launch - 17 applications. Meeting held 11/1/10 - verbal report from ClIr Bond/ClIr Ms Hall -

There is an increasing group of people contributing, £508 raised so far. 4 quotes for proposed design schemes, going back for more detailed quotes and writing a business plan for next 3 years, breaking project into bite size chunks, group have agreed it would be a good idea to replace removed swing ASAP, hopefully in place by mid July, possibly funded by Neighbourhood Forum grants, Taylor Newton & Hibbert Charity and PC designated funds in Furness account, a sub-committee has formed for fundraising events and group plan to re-launch 100 club again next month.

Regarding plans for 1st phase of new play equipment, Mr Bertlin commented that "something should be done sooner rather than later".

Members of the Parish Council were delighted that the group are making good progress with the refurbishment project.

COUNTY CLLR AND DISTRICT COUNCILLOR REPORTS.

County Councillor Wearing reported that the proposed footpath from Lyndene Drive to Alnat Estate will not be as long as originally proposed as 20m of the wall will not support footpath unless £6k of remedial work is done (Cllr Wearing will allocate from his budget for 2011/12)

He also reported that there is grit available for parish supplies if weather worsens, if parish

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has not taken up offer, consider for future years and employing someone to grit.
District Cllr Holmes reported that Crosthwaite PC are investigating a self help consortium
scheme with 5/6 villages to store and distribute to secondary roads and this may be
something the parish may be interested in joining, subject to budget provision being
available.
