#### PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE

MEMBERS OF THE PARISH COUNCIL AGREED THAT THEY ARE NOT OPPOSED TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT BUT ARE UNABLE TO SUPPORT THE APPLICATION IN RESPECT OF THE FOLLOWING POINTS AND THEREFORE OBJECT AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. WE ARE CONCERNED THAT THERE SHOULD BE NO SIGNIFICANT INCREASE TO THE LEVELS OF LIGHT POLLUTION THAT ALREADY EXIST IN THE AREA OF THE DEVELOPMENT.
- 2. WE REQUEST THAT 'PROPOSED ACCESS ROAD TO FUTURE DEVELOPMENT' TO BE REMOVED BECAUSE OF THE ASSUMPTION IT MAKES REGARDING THE ACCEPTABILITY OF ANY FURTHER COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE ADJOINING LAND AND RIBBON DEVELOPMENT ALONG KENDAL ROAD.
- 3. THERE IS INADEQUATE SCREENING TO THE DEVELOPMENT FROM THE NORTH EAST APPROACH WHERE THERE SHOULD BE ADDITIONAL EARTH MOUNDING.
- 4. WE HAVE CONCERNS THAT THERE ARE NOT SUFFICIENT STAFF PARKING SPACES APPROPRIATE FOR THE NUMBERS OF STAFF IDENTIFIED IN THE APPLICATION.
- 5. IN THE INTEREST OF HIGHWAY SAFETY CONSIDERATION BE GIVEN TO THE INCLUSION OF A FOOTPATH ALONGSIDE THE SITE BOUNDARY WHICH WILL ALSO ALLOW GARAGE CUSTOMERS TO WALK AND ACCESS VILLAGE FACILITIES AND SERVICES SAFELY.
- 6. WE WOULD ASK THAT HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT CONSIDER EXTENDING THE 30 MPH ZONE LIMIT BEYOND ACCESS TO THE BMW & MINI GARAGES AND PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT.
