It is also our understanding that complex applications of this nature and when there is a difference between planners and parish council support that it should be dealt

The LDNPA have brought it to our attention this may be a breach of planning consent as it is classed as trading. She will investigate further and contact me again. I brought to her attention that there is frequently unloading of vehicles at the Hadwin's VW garage very late at night and we have raised concerns of neighbours in the area. She advised that is because it will be part of the planning consent of an established business premises. The village hall/land is not classed as business premises and therefore could be unauthorised. She is to contact Jane Hodgson from village hall management committee to establish more information.

They have recently launched the "Call for Sites Consultation" and would like to hear from local residents and parish councils about any sites that may be suitable for accommodating local and affordable housing, employment and open space/formal recreation areas in each of the rural service centres. This is the first stage in identifying possible sites and so they are essentially seeking "anything and everything" at this stage of the process. It doesn't matter at this stage if there are possible constraints to development, the LDNPA will ultimately only allocate the most suitable sites, but unless they are told about potential sites at this stage, it is possible that they won't be used in the future.

If we want help from a policy planner to help us identify sites we can contact LDNPA. Site suggestion form/marked on map to be submitted for each site identified. Multiple sites can be marked on map as long as clearly referenced.

Councillor Bill Wearing has already requested that Cumbria Highways assess the feasibility of a scheme to extend the footway from Lyndene Drive to Lindale, thus creating a continuous pedestrian route from Lindale to Grange. If a scheme is practicable, it will be added to the list of candidate schemes for possible inclusion in a future years capital highways improvements programme. The programmes are prioritised in accordance with a priority scoring system which assesses a scheme's capacity to contribute towards delivery of the Council's Local Transport Plan objectives. At this stage I am unable to say when a scheme, if feasible, would be able to be funded and delivered. However, I hope that the initial assessment will be able to be completed within the next few weeks.

If a footway extension scheme is not feasible, Keith Masser Area Engineer has said "we would be happy to look at what alternative measures might be able to be provided to help pedestrians feel safer when using the road"

Clerk has advised Ms Monkman Brushett of response to ourselves and Tim Farron MP as above.
